Research

My study group investigates factors influencing the disease course in pediatric inflammatory bowel disease. In doing so, we focus on translational studies employing blood, tissue, and stool samples of patients. We want to answer questions about predictors of prognosis, triggers of acute flares, and pathogenic mechanisms.

Our research is supported by grants from the Insel Gruppe AG and different foundations including Gottfried und Julia Bangerter-Rhyner foundation, Fondazione Ettore e Valeria Rossi and Batzebär. The research efforts of me and my students resulted in multiple peer-reviewed publications, honors and awards.
